The annual Erie March for Life will take place this Saturday, beginning and concluding at Perry Square. The March is organized by People for Life. All who share our organization's mission of ensuring legal protection and promoting appreciation for all human lives, especially the lives of the unborn and other very vulnerable demographics, are welcome and highly encouraged to participate.

The theme of this year's March is *Inclusion for All: We can do this!*

After being limited to the sidewalks around Perry Square last year because of the City of Erie's COVID-19 policies, the 2022 Erie March for Life will once again take to the streets of downtown Erie. From Perry Square we will proceed west on W. 6th St., south on Sassafras, east on W. 10th St. and north on State back to Perry Square.

The March will begin at 11 a.m. Participants are asked to assemble at the Pavilion in West Perry Square by 10:45 a.m.

The March will conclude at the Perry Square Pavilion with a program of speakers. The program will conclude by 12:30 p.m., or possibly earlier because of the frigid temperatures.

We are very pleased to be hosting a fine slate of speakers.

People for Life volunteer Nichole Bryson, our keynote speaker, will describe the trauma that abortion holds for women, sharing the message, "After 22 years, I still regret my abortion."

We will also hear from Gannon University Students for Life President Sarah White and VP Christopher Abraham; Erie County Council President Brian Shank; and Melanie Brewer, District Director for pro-life Congressman Mike Kelly. Father Andy Boyd of St. George Church will open and close the proceedings with a word of prayer.

Our designated spokespeople will be: Shauna Jackson, Karli Van Der Volgen, and Nichole Bryson.
